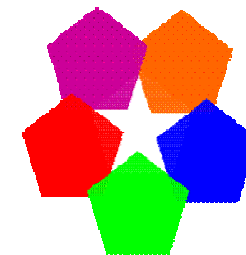

# What is an Extended School?

Extended Schools provide a range of services and activities often beyond the school day, which motivate and support children & young people to achieve their full potential.

What's on offer depends on what the local community want and need. Schools do not have to provide the entire extended services core offer themselves or on their site; if a service can't be offered on the school site, It can usually be found nearby.

There are five elements to the full core offer:

**1. Childcare: Giving children a good start in the early years and supporting parents.** Wrap around childcare for primary schools which could include breakfast and after school clubs. Services will be developed in line with the needs of families and may be offered on school site or the school may signpost you to services available in the wider community.

**2. Varied menu of activities: giving children and young people opportunities to take part in activities during out of school hours including school holidays:** Activities could include: After school sports, dance, art, ICT, home work club, school holiday activities and other special interest clubs.

## 3. Parenting Support

- Family learning opportunities
- Access to a range of structural parenting courses
- Adult education
- Parent drop-in services, for informal opportunities to talk to schools, attend coffee mornings & workshops and to meet other parents

**4. Swift and easy access: the school can support & direct you to the relevant people to get the right specialist support for your child.**

For example:

- Health services
- Speech and language therapy
- Behaviour support
- Youth workers/ advisors

## 5. Community Access: Opening the doors to the

**community :** Many schools offer the use of their facilities (there may be a hire charge), this could include sports facilities, dance studios, gym ICT facilities, school halls & meeting rooms.
