## The two versions of the Register of Electors

The Electoral Registration Officer makes and keeps two versions of the Electoral Register – the Full Register and the Edited Register.

### The Full Register

The full register lists everyone who is entitled to vote. You can check it at the St Martins Place, 51, Bath Road, Slough, SL1 3UF during normal office hours by appointment only.

The full register is used for elections and referendums, preventing and detecting crime and checking applications for credit. The law says who can have a copy of the Full Register and what they can use it for. The full list of such persons and purposes are in the Representation of the People (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2002. It is a criminal offence for them to pass it on to anyone else or to use it for any other purpose.

### The Edited Register

The edited register is available for general sale and can be used for any purpose. Leaving your name out of the edited register will not affect your voting rights or your credit status. If you do not tick the box your details will be sold to anyone buying a copy.
