

FIVE MEMBER REQUISITION FOR AN EXTRAORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING - MOTION ON NATIONALITY AND BORDERS BILL CLAUSE 9

We, the undersigned councillors, hereby request that in accordance with Procedure Rule 3.1(vi) an extraordinary meeting of the Full Council is convened to consider the following motion.

"The diversity of Slough's community is a product of the town's long and proud history of welcoming people from all over the world.

This Council is therefore concerned that Clause 9 of the Nationality and Borders Bill, via its powers to remove citizenship from individuals, will create a second-class tier of citizenship for naturalised British citizens.

The Council agrees to write to the Home Secretary to ask;

- *The government remove and replace Clause 9 from the Nationality and Borders Bill;*
- *Work with Local Authorities and communities to build a fairer and more effective asylum system."*
