**APPLICATION FOR A STREET TRADING CONSENT  
413 LONDON ROAD SLOUGH SL3 8PS**

I note from your letter of 30 August that you have an Application for Street Trading Consent at the lay-by at the above address. I wish to object to the Application on the following grounds:

1. The proposed area is largely restricted for cars because of double yellow parking lines. The site is on a dual carriageway. Access is possible for traffic heading into Slough but problems may arise from traffic turning and wishing to re-gain the Slough-bound carriageway, while drivers may be tempted to use the present No Entry access increasing the danger of accidents on an already busy and dangerous road.
2. There will be an inevitable detriment to the environment through litter resulting from discarded cups, containers, and paper.
3. The proposed site is close to residential property. I am concerned this may result in opportunistic crime such as breaking and entering houses. The proposed facility being close to a bus shelter may cause elderly passengers some discomfort particularly late at night from any rowdy behaviour.

Finally although this cannot be grounds for objection under current legislation I do feel that the proposed trading of the nature described will create an unfavourable impression to visitors to Slough.
