We wish to lodge an objection to the proposed application for street trading consent opposite 413 London Road Langley Slough SL3 8PS.

We would like to point out that this not a lay-by but a service road for access to Foxborough Close, The Toby Carvery and ourselves at 413 London Road.

The amount of free space parking is very limited and there would be no guaranteed parking for customers unless they did so on the double yellow lines.

Running from end to end of the north side of the service road is a cycle path, this takes up half the width of total road, with the limited parking on the south side customers to the proposed food stall would be forced to park on this cycle lane.

Please can you take these points we have made into consideration before you make your final decision.
