Prevention of Crime and Disorder	Please tick	On the 10 <sup>th</sup> May 2011, officers of the Trading Standards Service found 86 packets of cigarettes and 14 pouches of tobacco that were hidden in the store. The products contravened the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008, and the Tobacco Products (Manufacture, Presentation and Sale)(Safety) Regulations 2007. This also points to duty evasion.		
Public Safety		See above. The Tobacco Products etc regulations are designed to warn the public of the dangers of using the tobacco products by requiring warnings to be both in English and displayed in a pictorial manner. The products seized had no pictorial warnings and no English warnings.
