On 19th October 2010 Slough Borough Council Trading Standards Officers carried out an underage test pruchase operation at Harshini Food and Wine. The Premises Licence holder at that time was Mr Manickam Rajeetharan, whose real name as previously stated is Rajeetharan Sivarajah. During that operation a bottle of WKD Vodka was sold to a 16 year old boy.

Thames Valley Police subsequently submitted an application for the Review of the Premises Licence which detailed stataments and evidence form the Trading Standards Officers.

The Review application was heard by the Licensing Sub Committee in January 2011 and full details of the determination will be detailed by the Licensing Team.

In light of the the previous Review application, the seizure of the counterfeit alcohol on 27th April 2011 and of the impending prosecution the Trading Standards officers are of the opinion that the Premises Licence should be revoked on the grounds of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety and the protection of Children from Harm
