**Under Section B - Films – Object** to finish time of 01.00am - request finish time to be **midnight**

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

**Under Section E – Live Music**

Under Non Standard Timings wording to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

**Under Section F – Recorded Music indoors only**

Police **object** to any **outdoor** music under the public nuisance licensing objective being potentially undermined, as the premise is located in a very residential area.

Under Non Standards Timings wording to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

**Under Section G – Performance of Dance**

Non Standard Timings wording to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section H – Anything of a similar description to that falling within (e), (f) or (g) – **Indoors only**

Police **object** to outdoors music,dance or anything of a similar description, under the public nuisance licensing objective being potentially undermined, as the premise is located in a very residential area.

Non Standard Timings wording to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section I – Provision of facilities for making music – **Indoors only**

Police **object** to any outdoor activity under the public nuisance licensing objective being potentially undermined, as the premise is located in a very residential area.

Non Standard Timings wording to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section J – Provision of facilities for dancing

Police **object** to any stage or existing wooden flooring and any outdoor activity including dancing until midnight under the public nuisance licensing objective being potentially undermined as the premise is located in a very residential area.

Non Standard Timings to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section K – Provision of facilities for entertainment of a similar description to that falling within I or J

Non Standard Timings to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section L – Late Night Refreshment

**Finish time to be 00.30 hours**

Non Standard Timings to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staf will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section M – Supply of Alcohol

Non Standard Timings to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

Under Section O – Hours premises are open to the Public

Finish Time to be 00.30 hours 7 days of the week.

Non Standard Timings to be:

Christmas Eve, New Years Eve, Deepavali Festival, Eid and any International Sporting Event to 01.00am. 10 days written notice to be given to Thames Valley Police Licensing and Slough Borough Council Licensing Department. SIA door staff will be employed if required by Thames Valley Police on these events.

**Thames Valley Police request the following conditions are placed on the licence:**

Digital CCTV monitoring system to be installed and maintained to Thames Valley Police standard. Recordings to be kept securely for 31 days and made available to Police or relevant Agencies on request.

Nominated person to be able to down load any CCTV footage that is requested by Thames Valley Police.

The Garden area is closed to the public after 10.00pm except for smokers and no drinks are allowed in this area after 10.00pm.

Designated Premises Supervisor or nominated person to attend the local pubwatch scheme.

If the applicant agrees to all the amendments and conditions there will be no police objections.
