I informed Mr Hussain that TVP had received 2 separate complaints of the advertising on facebook (see attached) Mr Hussain was informed that this sort of advertising is not acceptable. He stated that the promoter had put the comments on facebook and not him and as soon as I had informed him the day before on the telephone of the issue, the promoter had taken the comments of. We then went through the conditions on the licence and Mr Hussain was informed that all the conditions on the licence must be adhered to otherwise this is a breach of licence. He assured me that all the conditions would be in place. I also informed him that we would be attending on Friday 3rd

Nature of Incident:

Attended premise to check that all the conditions on the premise licence were being adhered to. As we entered the premise it appeared to us to not be ready for trading. The best description for the venue was that it was like a warehouse, there was no proper flooring in place, we were informed the CCTV was not working due to a leak, no heating (it was really cold in the venue) and there were limited drinks. Door staff badges checked, no drugs register seen and no metal detector in place and when I questioned one of the door staff about this he then got a hand wand detector out and said that they would use that and no door staff signing in and out register in place.

Details of Person(s) arrested or reported and offences:

MR Hussain, DPS was on site but not particularly helpful, he kept disappearing during our visit. Very disappointing. As we left the premise Mr Hussain was informed that we would be back to ensure that the CCTV was working and if it was not working action may have to be taken.

We returned back to the venue at approximately 2300 hours, Mr Hussain informed us that the CCTV was still not working and someone was working on it. When I asked to see the CCTV hard drive and cameras I was shown a hole in the ceiling by the DJ booth, when I asked who was working on the system to fix it he pointed to a male, who was stood by the wall. The male came over - I then said to Mr Hussain, well he is

Action taken in all other cases:

Not working on the CCTV now is he? At that point both Mr Hussain and the other male invaded my personal space and I had no other choice but to raise both my hands to signal to them both to move away from me. At this point it was crystal clear that the CCTV was not going to be working this evening. We left the premise and I informed the DPS that the Inspector would be attending the premise to issue a Section 19 for the breach of premises licence. At 11.23pm Sergeant 4806 Newsome served a Section 19 on the DPS. Advice given that if they continue to trade in breach of their licence under this notice they could be subject to a £20k fine or 6 months in prison. Advice given to close the premise at midnight. We witnessed

Telephone conversation with Mr Hussain, DPS and Debie Pearmain, PLO. Conversation witnessed and heard by PC Simpson, PC Harrison and Rachael Rumney, SBC.

I telephoned Mr Hussain at midday as I believed he was not going to turn up to the pre-arranged meeting today at midday. I informed Mr Hussain that I had a Police Officer and Council Licensing Officer and myself waiting for him at the Police Station. He informed me that he was in High Wycombe and did not

Nature of Incident:

Think that he had to come in still, as we had attended the premise on Thursday last week. I informed Mr Hussain that I had not cancelled this meeting and that I was extremely disappointed that he failed to turn up. Particularly following the issue on Friday evening where a Section 19 closure order was served. To date the CCTV is still not working. Mr Hussain informed me that he was not opening this weekend, Friday and Saturday and that he plans to open on Friday 17th February 2012 - I advised him very strongly that the Police need to visit the premise and check that the CCTV is working - when this has been done a cancellation notice can be issued. I also informed Mr Hussain that I was very disappointed with the way

Details of Person(s) arrested or reported and offences:

We were dealt with on Friday evening during our licensing inspection, he kept disappearing. Mr Hussain stated that if we had turned up at 8.30pm he would have been able to spend more time with us. Mr Hussain had a very negative attitude towards me and if this is his attitude now it does cause Thames Valley Police concern as to the way the premise will be managed, it would appear that he does not want to work with the Police and Local Authority. That is certainly my view.

I agreed with Mr Hussain to attend the premise with a Police Officer on Thursday 16th February 2012 between 3pm -4pm to check the CCTV and if this was all in order a cancellation notice would be issued

RABZ – High Street, Slough

At 1515 hours on Thursday 16th February 2012 I attended RABZ nightclub with Sergeant Piper, Town Centre Sergeant, Rachael Rumney, Senior Licensing Officer, SBC – the visit was to check the CCTV system in relation to the breach of licence condition and the Section 19 notice being served on Mr Hussain, DPS on the 3rd February 2012 for breach of this condition.

Sergeant Piper checked the CCTV system, which had 6 working cameras. I noted and informed Sergeant Piper that not all the licensable area upstairs was covered by CCTV. We went to the upstairs area and Sergeant Piper then informed Mr Hussain that he was not satisfied with the CCTV coverage upstairs and at this stage was not going to issue a cancellation notice for the Section 19. Mr Hussain was fully updated by Sergeant Piper of our concerns with the upstairs area. He stated that the promoter only wanted to use the downstairs area. Sergeant Piper then stated that whilst the upstairs area was not being used, he would like an extra camera fitted and recording the stair area and if this was done, he would be satisfied with this. He also stated he would like physical barriers put in place at the top of the stairs to stop customers entering the upstairs area, which is not covered by CCTV. Mr Hussain agreed to do this. I then informed Mr Hussain that Thames Valley Police would return Friday afternoon (the next day) to ensure that the extra camera and barriers were in place and if this was done, a cancellation notice would be issued. Mr Hussain was also informed that if the extra camera was not in place Thames Valley Police would not serve a cancellation notice. Further advice also given re further breaches. Sergeant Piper also advised Mr Hussain of the trip hazard at the top of the stairs and advised him to rectify this.

We left the premises at 3.35pm.

As I was walking along the High Street I was handed a flyer advertising and promoting Rabz (see attached flyer).

I made the following observations on the flyer:

1. Capacity advertised as 700
2. Drinks promotions
3. VIP tables being advertised (No CCTV in the VIP area, I was previously informed by Mr Hussain this was upstairs)

On Friday 17th February 2012 at approximately 1.00pm I telephoned Mr Hussain to enquire if the camera had been installed – he confirmed that it had. I informed Mr Hussain that I would be attending the premise at approximately 2.00pm.

At 2.15pm on Friday 17th February 2012 I attended Rabz with PC 3000 Williams, Town Centre Officer and Rachael Rumney, Senior Licensing Officer, SBC. CCTV was checked and the extra camera had been installed. PC Williams then issued the Cancellation notice for the Section 19.

I then informed Mr Hussain of my concerns over the flyer and what was being advertised. I reminded him that the capacity was 650 and not 700. Rachael

Rumney and I informed him of our concerns in relation to the cheap drinks being advertised. I also informed Mr Hussain that if there were any alcohol related crime and disorder issues at the premise we would have to become involved. Rachael informed him of the mandatory condition concerning drinks promotions.

I then informed Mr Hussain my initial concern re the advertising of the VIP tables, as I knew this area was upstairs and not currently covered by CCTV. Mr Hussain stated that the VIP area was now downstairs, I can confirm that the brown seating/sofas that were upstairs had been moved downstairs.

I once again reminded Mr Hussain not to use the upstairs area until CCTV was covering the licensable area and if he did so this would be a breach of licence condition and appropriate action would be taken.

We left the premise at approximately 2.35pm

On Friday 17th February 2012 at 10.00pm I attended the premise to conduct a licensing check. I spoke to Mr Hussain and I checked the upstairs area, which had the barriers in place and CCTV was working.

As I left the premise I spoke to one of the doorstaff and asked if they were using the search wand on customers entering the premise. He advised me that they were not. Advice given to ensure that they used the search wand as this was a condition on the licence. I then asked if they had been briefed by the DPS to use the search wand. He informed me that they had not been briefed on anything.

As agreed in our meeting this morning I am sending this message to confirm our discussions.

As well as us Dan Lord of the Professional Sound Company was present and also my colleague Rhian Richards. I have also copied in all persons with an official interest.

The purpose of our meeting was to discuss the issue of noise nuisance to nearby residents created by the PA system in Rabz Nightclub at 305 High Street Slough.

A notice was served in this regard and having been breached on 10/3/2012 was the subject of an earlier meeting between yourself and officers from Slough BC on 13/3/12.

During the meeting today we clarified that the notice still stands and **any breach** tomorrow, Saturday or at any time in the future will still be treated as **an offence** and we advised that should offences continue we would consider seeking a **warrant** from the magistrates court to seize all noise making equipment.

You suggested the following interim measures to alleviate the noise after consultation with your adviser Dan;

1. All speakers on the first floor upper level to be disabled/turned off.
2. Speakers below the flat roofed area to the High Street side of the premises to be disabled /turned off including any near the entrance door.
3. The double door entrance/exit to be manned by security personnel who are to be advised to ensure that both sets of doors are to be closed when not in use. When people enter and leave an arrangement must be applied where only one set of doors is open at any one time – the purpose of this is to prevent sound breakout.
4. The PA system to be turned "right down" to a level that you and Dan consider acceptable.

PLEASE NOTE The caveat for point 4 is as set out above ie the notice still stands and so any nuisance created may be treated as an offence for which you may be prosecuted and/or may assist in any representations we make to the court for a warrant to seize equipment.

In the long term you agreed that Dan Lord would provide details of acoustics' consultants who would prepare a schedule of attenuation (noise reducing works) to the premises which could include for example bricking up windows , roof sound insulation, noise limiting devices, reinforcing the front window and wood building face for example.

We will have officer patrolling Friday and Saturday and will advise you of their observations as to the improvements or otherwise that these measures achieve.

We suggest that once you have some firm outline proposals from your acoustic consultants that we meet again to discuss the proposals . In the meantime please respond and confirm that the measures 1 to 4 above will be carried out pending such works and that you understand that the notice still stands and any breach is an offence.

Thank you for your time today which was very much appreciated.

No seperate first aid room. On cctv staff had no external smoking area _ and they were allowed to come and go at will with no searches and exit and re enter with what looks like alcohol in bottles.

Other Information:

Upon arrival door staff at entrance did not have radio and no way of communicating with other SIA staff. He said he had given his radio to the girls at the bar as they were getting harassed by patrons. He was unable to identify the manager by name or location. He was unable to identify or contact the door supervisor. There was only one clicker and this was with the supervisor who was not on the door had to estimate the number of occupants. He was unable to call any other members of staff or direct me to injured persons. I was left with just having to go in and deal with what we found.

This is a shockingly bad establishment. SIA staff were inadequate in number to deal with even the smallest of incidents. Injured party was treating self in the kitchen area with tea towels and a dish rag.

They couldn't control the door/nightclub area. They did not appear to have a first aid room, any first aid kit i could see.

The sia door staff on the door did not have a radio. He was unable to direct me to injured persons or contact the SIA supervisor or licencee.

They couldn't even switch the lights on. They had no external smoking area and it can be seen from the cctv nobody is being searched as the enter/re enter and they are allowed to exit/re enter with bottles containing liquid.

This is the poorest pub i have been in in 15 years.

On 14/04/2012 at 02.31 hours, three separate calls were made to Thames Valley Police regarding RABZ nightclub, one of them was from a local resident complaining about the loud noise coming from there. The further two calls were from local residents who were witnessing a fight breaking out when the club was kicking out. Police were called to the incident to find a male laying outside the club, unconscious with a pool of blood next to him. Although it transpired that it was not life threatening, crowds gathered from those who had left the club and were seen to be shouting and punching at the shutters of another shop. The crowds hung around for half an hour or more and the nightclub closed.

Details of Person(s) arrested or reported and offences:

date of birth: was arrested on suspicion of assault ABH, although there were possibly others involved; the cctv could not pick this up due to the large formation of crowds.

Action taken in all other cases:

was seen involved in the incident amongst approximately 20-30 people congregating outside the club. CCTV had directed the police to him whilst he tried to flee the area in a taxi. The crowds were not dispersed straight away due to the number of people present and the fact an injured male lay on the floor. My name is _____ and I live at _____
Slough SL _____ which is situated _____ RABZ NIGHT CLUB.

I write to express my on going concerns regarding premises at 308 High Street Slough, currently operating as "RABZ".

Since the opening, there have been various, repeated disturbances which do not allow me peaceful enjoyment of my property.

Reports have been made to the relevant bodies concerning episodes of disturbance which include (but are not limited to) street disorder, breach of noise regulations, public order offences, crimes against the person and I believe, breach of licensing obligations/conditions.

I find that the ongoing disruption are affecting me psychologically, emotionally, occupationally and financially.

My sleep duration is grossly reduced during the operational hours of the business. I work as front line Staff nurse for the NHS and am required to regularly work unsocial hours. Lack of sleep impairs my performance and potentially endangers the vulnerable adults that I work with.

I now experience an anxiety provoking stressful anticipation of disturbance from the premises which is distressing. There has been an occasion where noise from patrons in the street was sufficiently disturbing as to necessitate my leaving my property at 03.00hrs.

There have been concerns of violent and aggressive behaviour outside the club, including a potentially serious assault, which I cannot avoid witnessing.

I have had to excuse myself from work on at least one occasion owing to a very disturbed night. This causes financial damage to me personally and is problematic for my employer.

I have a diagnosed neurological condition known to be exacerbated by reduced sleep and it is of major concern that a relapse may be triggered as a result of these

disturbances. I have already experienced a return of some symptoms which is indicative of reduced symptom control and decreased neurological stability

At times, I feel unsafe to leave my property as patrons tend to "spill out" into the street and, at times, the entrance to my property. Litter levels have increased and there have been incidences of vomit and urine in the entrance. This is a risk to my health and safety as well as being deeply distasteful and unpleasant. Traffic noise has also increased and the increased presence of emergency services gives the area a "no-go" feeling at times.

I would appreciate any assistance that you can give in the resolution of this situation.
