

## Notice of Forthcoming Key Decisions and/or Decisions to be Taken in Private

Published in Accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements)  
 (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

### Decisions to be made by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016

Local authorities are required to publish a Notice of key decisions and/or of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive ('the Cabinet') in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. This Notice sets out key decisions to be taken in private at the meeting of the Cabinet on 11th April 2016 which have not been included on previously published statutory notices (the Forward Plan). In accordance with the Regulations, the Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been consulted and has agreed for the items to be considered in private at the meeting.

Item	SEN and PRU Expansion Programme: Phase 1
Ward	All
Reason for urgency	The Cabinet will consider a report seeking approval to make progress on implementing Phase 1 of the expansion programme of places to meet immediate and future need for Special Education Needs and Pupil Referral Unit provision. Notice of the decision was published in the statutory notice for the 11 <sup>th</sup> April Cabinet, however, since publication it has been decided to include exempt information relating to the financial and business affairs of the authority requiring consideration in private. The decisions cannot reasonably be deferred until the next meeting on 20 <sup>th</sup> June 2016 as doing so would cause undue risk to the timetable of providing the required expansion.

Item	Maple House - Proposed Lease Surrender & Renewal
Ward	Central
Reason for urgency	The Cabinet will consider a report seeking decisions in relation to the lease of Maple House, Slough. This is a further report to that considered by Cabinet in December 2015. The decision cannot be reasonably deferred until the next meeting on 20 <sup>th</sup> June 2016 to enable officers to continue and conclude negotiations and progress with the proposed way forward in a timely manner.
