One Way Traffic System – Belgrave Road

Since a “no kerb parking” policy has been applied to Belgrave Road (Stoke Road end) parking for the residents and their visitors have become intolerable on this narrow road. This situation has inevitably led to parked cars on the road being hit and damaged. In many cases drivers have not reported the damage they have caused. Repairs have been noted to result in amounts up to several thousand pounds.

We, the residents of Belgrave Road urgently demand that the section of the road become one way in order to facilitate the reduction of such incidents.

Council Response

I am writing in response to your petition regarding your request to introduce a one way system on Belgrave Road.

We have undertaken a site visit to determine whether your road is suitable for a one way street and as part of this visit we will be undertaking further investigations to check the benefits of introducing a one way restriction.

If not properly introduced one way streets have a tendency to encourage speeding, therefore before any decision is made we will undertake traffic surveys to identify the volume and speed of vehicles on Belgrave Road.

Furthermore, we will also look at any recorded accidents on this section and subject to the results and funding we will determine whether we can introduce a one way restriction on this section.
