Proposed variation:

To extend the hours for the sale of alcohol to 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

To remove all the embedded restrictions set out in Annex 2 on the premises licence.

To remove all the conditions set out in Annex 2 on the premises licence.

To include the conditions set out in boxes b to e of Section M of the operating schedule:

- 1. A digital CCTV system will be installed, or the existing system maintained, such a system to be fit for the purpose.
- 2. The CCTV system shall be capable of producing immediate copies on site. Copies of the recordings will either be recorded digitally on to CD/DVD or other equivalent medium.
- 3. Any recordings will be retained and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of 31 days and shall be made available, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, to the police for inspection on request.
- 4. The precise positions of the cameras may be agreed, subject to compliance with Data Protection legislation, with the police from time to time.
- 5. The system will display, on any recording, the correct time and date of the recording.
- 6. The CCTV system will be maintained and fully operational throughout the hours that the premises are open for any licensable activity.

The premises licence holder will at all times maintain adequate

levels of staff. Such staff levels will be disclosed, on request, to the licensing authority and police.

Adequate waste receptacles for use by customers shall be provided in and immediately outside the premises.

The premises licence holder will ensure that any age verification policy will apply to the premises whereby all cashiers will be trained to ask any customer attempting to purchase alcohol, who appears to be under the age of 25 years (or older if the licence holder so elects) to produce, before being sold alcohol, identification being a passport or photocard driving licence bearing a holographic mark or other form of identification that complies with any mandatory condition that may apply to this licence.

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and is subject to a maximum fine of £5000 on summary conviction.

This is a Petition to register objection against BP Oil UK Limited's application for an extension to the hours of sale of alcohol to 24 hours a day and 7 days a week.

The terms of Objection, in accordance with the Licensing Act (2003) are

- 1. the prevention of crime and disorder
- 2. public safety
- 3. the prevention of public nuisance
- 4. the protection of children from harm

Colnbrook already has a large number off licences and public houses in close proximity to this site, and has long suffered from a serious problem with large numbers of street drinkers and the associated nuisance resulting from their antisocial behaviour in the area, such as litter and public urination in the public areas nearby. In recent years, the problem of drunken behaviour has become worse and Thames Valley Police has been called to Brands Hill on numerous occasions.

Any proposals for new licensed establishments that would further compound the current problems in Brands Hill, Colnbrook should be strongly resisted and we do not want one that potentially sells alcohol 24 hours a day 7 days every week in this location.
