## **Objection to Bradley Road Double Yellow Lines**

We the undersigned wish to object to the parking restrictions (Double Yellow Lines) recently implemented at Bradley Road/Stoke Poges Lane Junction.

The objections for this are as follows:

- 1. With the cars being able to park here it forces all vehicles to slow down therefore improving road safety.
- 2. Accessibility for visitors and customers, helping with Slough's local economy.
- 3. Preventing inconsiderate parking, by allowing parking here it stops people parking on Bradley Road, Pool Lane blocking resident's driveways and access. If restrictions are added this will lead to further issues including resident disputes etc.
- 4. We also feel the double yellow lines have been imposed without fair consideration of the livelihood of residents, local shops and the limited availability of parking spaces.
- 5. There are businesses in the local area that provide significant benefits to the local community who will suffer due to people being driven away by the unfair and overzealous parking enforcement practice.
- 6. We feel the parking restrictions that have been implemented are extremely excessive and unnecessary on a residential street and they have already made a damaging impact on trade in the local shops.
- 7. As a grocery store who are already struggling with increasing costs daily we feel the impact of the inevitable lost custom will be calamitous.
- 8. Our customers had no other option but to take advantage of the limited parking spaces outside the shop on Bradley Road as there is no space for the store to make a car park.
- 9. We as a business pay our business rates and council tax yet the local authorities have shown complete disregard for our trade.

We urge Slough Borough Council to revoke the double yellow lines with immediate effect.
