## Handling of Parking Scheme - College Avenue

To whom it may concern,

Due to the current decision by the Council to cancel the agreed L1 parking zone we as residents of College Avenue strongly object to this decision and together have signed this petition for these permits to be reinstated. We have clearly been treated unfairly due to the Council's decision, where the permits were cancelled in the final hours even though payments were made by most residents.

The Council has cancelled these permits without any proper justification as responses to email and questions have only contradicted previous responses by the Council. You have decided to carry on with Kings Edwards Street, Kings Road and Ragstone Road (near McDonalds) and this has made it worse for us and we are now feeling the effect of this as Ragstone Road residents are parking on College Avenue. As a result of this, after 5pm, there is zero parking for residents of these streets. If you decided to cancel College Avenue and Martin Road you should also be cancelling the permits for these roads.

Chalvey Road East is one of the main issue for residents of College Avenue where there are now 3 car garages (2 on Chalvey Road and 1 on Martin Road) and these businesses use the local street to park there vehicles. Pictures were submitted as evidence of 2 cars that have been dumped on the road as work is being done to them.
