Petition - Abolish Double Yellow Lines - Finefield Walk

We wish to submit our petition to abolish the double yellow line that was enforced at Finefield Walk, SL1 2QR as per below:-

- 1) The enforcement of double yellow lines on 31/10/2019 at Finefield Walk, SL1 2QR was not done in a proper manner as the vote conducted at the AGM does not carry a fair representation of types of homes available at the development.
- 2) The vote was majority from homeowners who has 2 parking spaces but for the rest of us, we only have 1 parking space as the garage is not fit for purpose.
- 3) Voting system does not work for our development as there are different types of house:
 - i. Town houses (4 beds) with one parking space & garage which is not fit for purpose - 20%
 - ii. Houses (2 & 3 beds) with two parking space - 60%
 - iii. Apartments - 20%
- 4) A fair and justifiable parking implementation plan i.e. a combination of single yellow with timings and necessary double yellow at problem areas was submitted to the management company but not considered and we were informed that the council has refused it.
- 5) A house is meant to be an investment and place for happy life- unfortunately this has become poor investment and with no mental peace.
- 6) There is just NO OTHER MEANS for residents with 2 or more vehicles to park our vehicles and this have caused unnecessary stress and loss of enjoyment of our properties. We all are under tremendous stress to park our second car as we have left with no option. Some residents will be suffering financial losses due to this and effecting our livelihood.
- 7) A consultation was not carried out with town houses residents and an 'emergency solution' was implemented based on feedbacks from a 'selected' homeowner and a very biased management company.
- 8) Unfortunately, town houses problems were never considered, addressed and represented. We all have equal rights no matter on any grounds.
- 9) Homeowners SHOULD NOT be punished after investing close to £500,000 to purchase our homes under Slough Urban Renewal (SUR) due to unscrupulous people who parks selfishly.

We kindly request the Council to ABOLISH DOUBLE YELLOW LINES and adopt a fair parking control measures:-

- 1) Single yellow lines with time restrictions. (8am to 10am & 2pm to 4pm).
- 2) A combination of single yellow lines with time limits and double yellow at critical areas as attached. (8am to 10am & 2pm to 4pm).
- 3) Residents permit or parking bays for town house residents (like most areas in Slough).

Please be advised that this is Residential area and double yellow lines would cause major difficulties to the town house owners.

We Kindly request for fair justice and please find our consent from all town houses at Finefield Walk, SL1 2QR.

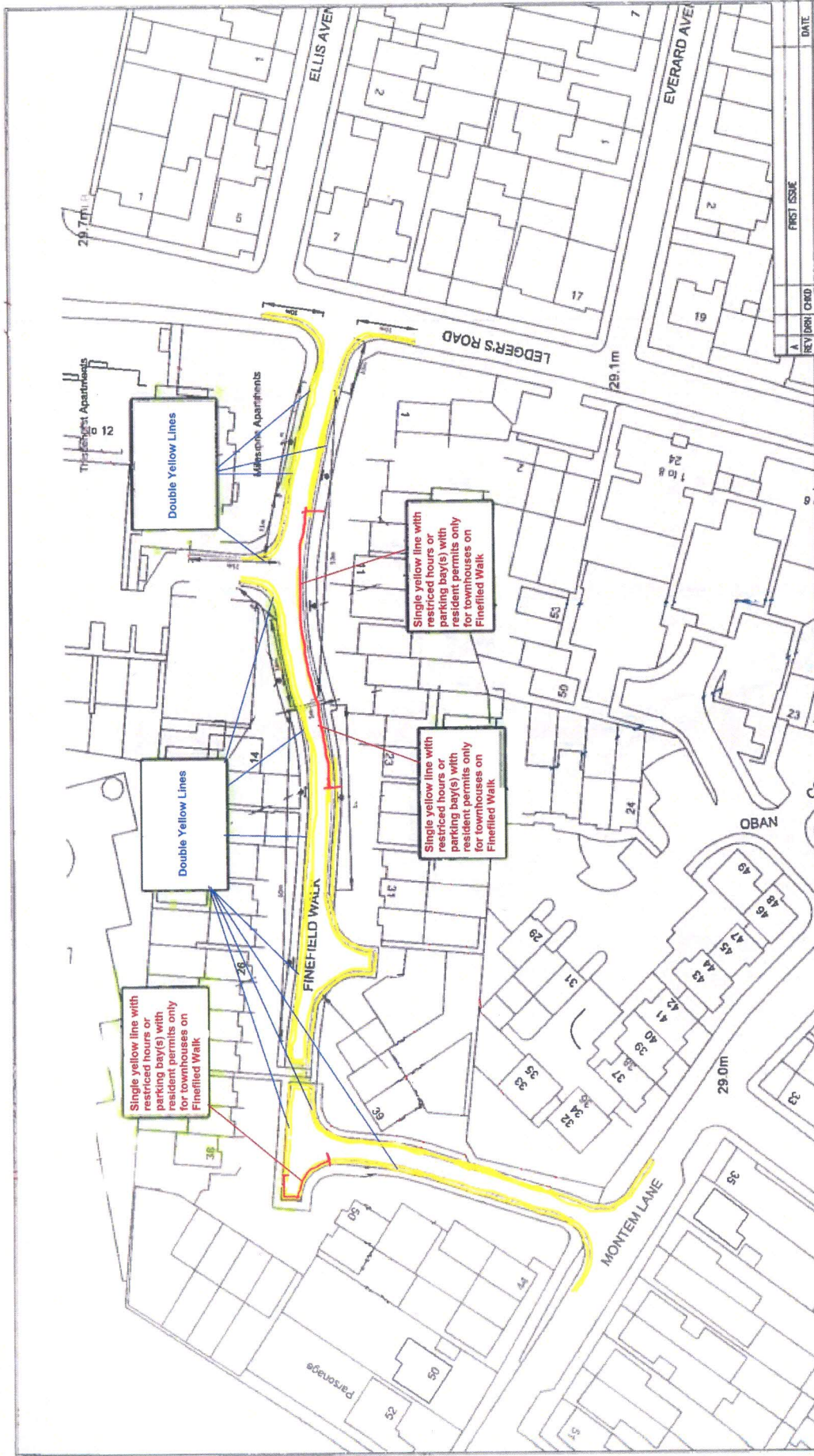

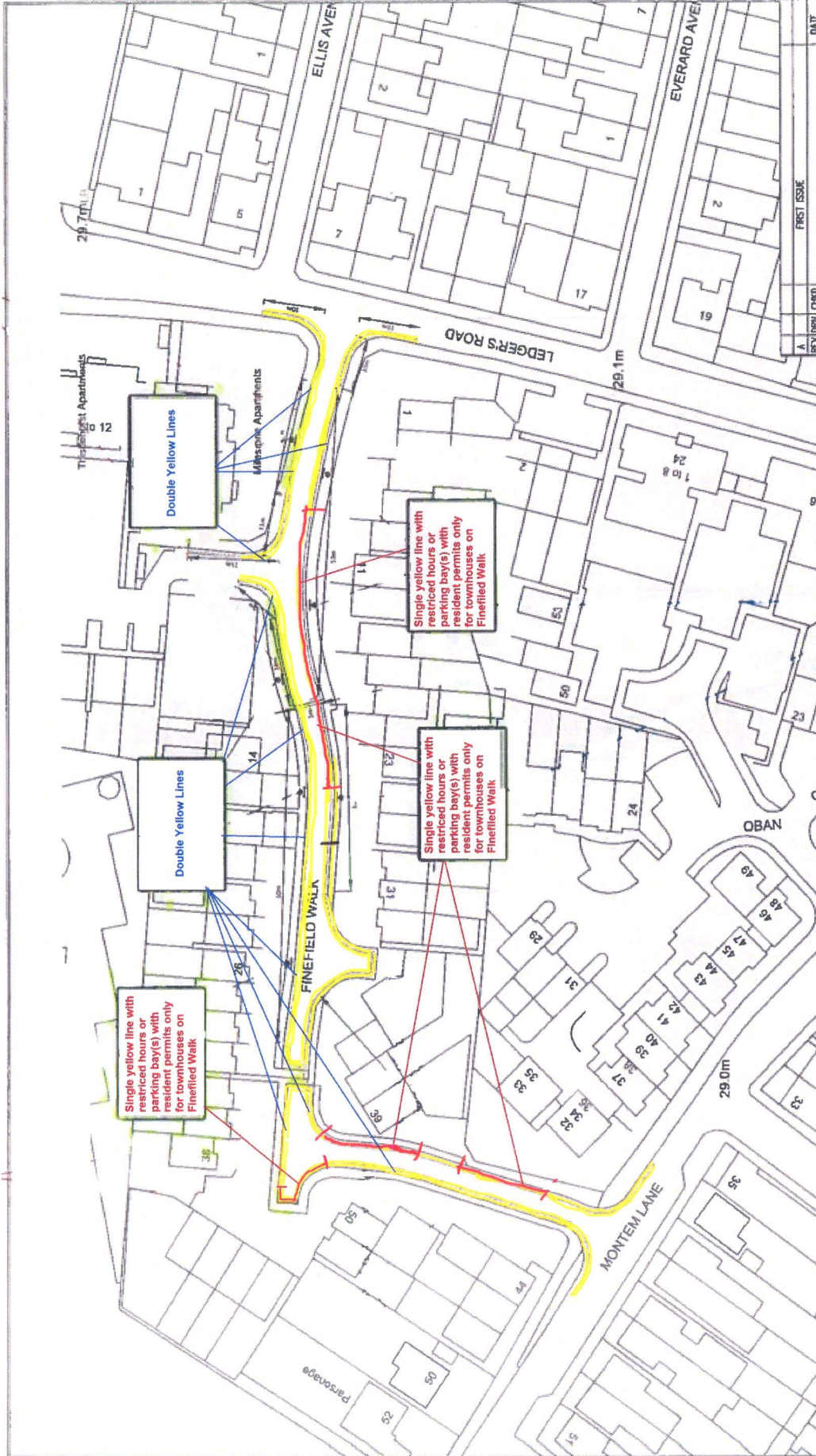
Thank you for submitting the attached petition.
