Parking Issues – Farnham Road

I am writing on behalf of the residents Farnham Road SL1 4XA. Parking has become major issue at SL1 4XA, we started to receive penalty fares, which is due to unlawful and misleading markings.

Please refer to photo 1 below, which clearly shows the marking that refers that there is an additional parking available which goes over the pavement, which we were parking on and had no issue previously. Now we started to get a ticket. We have a major issue with parking as it is. There is not even paid parking available in this area, and in addition we have this absolutely useless pavement and misleading marking, instead of creating parking area for residents, you made it more complicate and moreover it feels like a deliberate trap for issuing a ticket.

See, photo 2 as an example of additional parking space that is available, its width is 5.35 meters, which is enough for 2 additional car parking spaces. Which is not even public footpath space. There are 36 flats and 20 parking spaces.

We, the residents of SL1 4XA need more parking to be generated, even if not able to do so, at least such parking restrictions that you have in place in our area to be lifted, pavement to be removed in order to create an additional parking space. I kindly request to find a solution to our problem and get back to us. We pay council tax religiously and we do not get appropriate service in return. We are extremely unhappy with such actions taken towards us, residents of SL1 4XA, knowingly about remaining parking issues in our area, we do not even have paid parking, nothing is available whatsoever.

We hope this letter will help us to come to some sort of mutual agreement and we will not be required to take any further action against Council.
