

Notice of Forthcoming Key Decisions

Published in Accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Decisions to be made by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 31st March 2021

Local authorities are required to publish a Notice of key decisions and/or of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive ('the Cabinet') in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting.
