Safe and Wellbeing Reviews

1. **Purpose of Report**

To provide an update the Safe and Wellbeing Reviews for people with Learning Disabilities

2. **Recommendation(s)/Proposed Action**

The committees is requested to note this report

3. **The Slough Joint Wellbeing Strategy, the JSNA and the Five Year Plan**

This work supports the ambitions in our JSNA and five year plan to ensure the most vulnerable in our communities have the care and support they need to flourish.

3b. **Five Year Plan Outcomes**

The programme aims to meeting outcome 2

- *Outcome 1: Slough children will grow up to be happy, healthy and successful*
- *Outcome 2: Our people will be healthier and manage their own care needs*
- *Outcome 3: Slough will be an attractive place where people choose to live, work and stay*
- *Outcome 4: Our residents will live in good quality homes*
- *Outcome 5: Slough will attract, retain and grow businesses and investment to provide opportunities for our residents*

4. **An update on the Safe and Review Panels for the committee to note.**

1. NHSE has mandated in depth reviews by end of Jan 2022 of all inpatients with a learning disability or autism. This follows Norfolk Safeguarding Adults Board review of the deaths of 3 patients at Cawston Park Hospital

2. Frimley has 10 CCG inpatients, of whom 2 will be discharged shortly, so there are 8 reviews to complete.
3. Frimley also has 8 adults in secure hospitals and 1 child in tier 4 services, all of which are commissioned by specialised commissioning, and will be reviewed by them.
4. Individual actions from review findings will be followed up, and learning collated across all the reviews.
5. ICS Oversight Review Panels are required by end of February for the 8 patients reviewed by CCG and the 9 patients reviewed by specialised commissioning.
6. Frimley has a plan in place to deliver reviews on time; 4 panel dates set up in Jan and Feb
7. NHSE regional team supporting, assuring, and feeding findings into the regional delivery plan
8. Update will be provided in January

The outcomes from the review will be shared with the Slough Safeguarding Adults Board.

There is one patient from Slough who is being reviewed.
