18 November	SBC	Deadline for submitting any disapplication to the ESFA to move up to 0.5% of funding from the Schools Block to the High Needs Block.
Mid December	ESFA	Authority Pro-forma Tool (APT) is sent to Local Authorities with October 2023 census data and indicative Schools Block DSG. At this point SBC Finance models the funding for individual schools.
