

Notice of Forthcoming Key Decisions

Decisions to be made by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency Date of Notice: 14th April 2023

Local authorities are required to publish a Notice of key decisions and/or of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive ('the Cabinet') in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. This Notice sets out decisions to be taken at the meeting of the Cabinet on 17th April 2023 which have not been included on previously published statutory notices (the Forward Plan).
