## The Borough of Slough (London Road (A4) At Hillrise) No right-turn Traffic Order 2021 ("Proposed Order")

## Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended.

- 1. Slough Borough Council gives notice that it proposes to make an order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers.
- 2. If the Proposed Order comes into force, a right-turn prohibition would be introduced, such that no person causing any vehicle proceeding in an easterly direction along London Road (A4) shall, on reaching the junction with Hillrise, cause that vehicle to turn right into Hillrise.
- 3. The Proposed Order shall come into operation if and on the date that the Council publishes a notice stating that the Proposed Order has been made.
