

**Slough Borough Council**  
**Notice Of Proposals**  
**Slough Borough Council (Parks and Open Spaces) Public Spaces Protection Order 1**  
**of 2022 (“the Proposed Order”)**

**Notice is hereby given** that Slough Borough Council intends to make the above Public Spaces Protection Order under Sections 59 of the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (hereinafter called “the Act”) and all other enabling powers.

1. The Proposed Order would relate to the Borough of Slough as shown edged red on the Plan (“the Restricted Area”), the Plan is available for inspection as per paragraph 8 of this notice.

2. The effect of the Proposed Order would be to prohibit the following activities in the Restricted Area:

2.1 Continuing to drink what is reasonably believed to be alcohol or consuming intoxicating substances when required to stop doing so by a Police Officer or Police Community Support Officer.

2.2 Not surrendering any alcohol or intoxicating substances in his or her possession when required to do so by a Police Officer or Police Community Support Officer.

3. The Council seeks to make the Proposed Order because the above activities carried out in the Restricted Area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality. The effect or likely effect of this is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature, such as to make this unreasonable, and justifies the restrictions imposed by this Order.

4. The Council intends that the Proposed Order will last for 3 years from the date that it is made. The Council may seek to extend that period if it is satisfied that it is reasonable to do so in accordance with its statutory powers.

5. Please state the grounds on which your representation or objection is made.
