- Slough Borough Council gives notice that it proposes to make an order under section 14(1)(a) of the RTRA 1984 and any other enabling powers.
- If made, the Proposed Order will prohibit any traffic passing through Furnival Avenue, Slough SL2, from number 2 Furnival Avenue to 253 - 257 Farnham Road (BP Garage).
- 3. The Proposed Order is needed because works are or are proposed to be carried out on or near the road.
- 4. If made, the Proposed Order shall come into operation at 00:01 hours on Monday 14th August 2023 for a period of 18 months, or until the works have been completed whichever is sooner. All works are expected to be completed by 23:59 hours on Friday 18th August 2023.
- 5. An alternative route will be available for use while the Proposed Order is in force with a local diversion sign at the location. Advanced warning notices will be at the locations advising of the dates the works will be carried out. Access will be maintained for all local residents and businesses.
- 6. A copy of the Proposed Order and a plan showing the parts of the highway affected may be inspected at the site where the closure will take place or on the Slough Borough Council website at <u>https://www.slough.gov.uk/ttro</u>.
