Introductions and Welcome

- 1. Approve meeting notes All CPN members.

2. Mental Health Housing update -Ash

Ash provided a brief update to the CPN about the Mental Health re-commissioning of both Hope House and Hope Place (supported living accommodation for people with mental health needs). He explained that:

- The current arrangement for supported living accommodation for people with mental health needs had been extended for a year. This will allow enough time to gather key information to support future re-commissioning.
- $\circ~$ Ash will update the CPN about progress and timelines
- CPN representative will be invited part of project group (one member expressed interest in being part of the work).

3. Autism strategy 2024 - 2029 - Giuseppe and Sue

Giuseppe and Sue provided an update on the development of the Autism strategy for Slough. <u>Check out Appendix A Autism presentation</u>.

In summary:

- Following engagement events which has included the coproduction network and autism community, a new draft autism strategy has been written.
- The strategy aims to make Slough an autism friendly town.
- The engagement feedback have been grouped into eight themes listed below
 - Independent living
 - Support in the community
 - Integration with health care
 - Transitioning to adulthood
 - Employment, skills development, and training
 - Safeguarding
 - Preventing loneliness and isolation
 - Communication and information sharing
- The autism strategy will be presented to cabinet on 26th Feb 2024

Action:

We are seeking coproduction network volunteers and other residents with an interest in autism to

- Be involved in Autism steering group also to support co-chair meetings.
- Develop questionnaires around each themes to support the development of the action plan.
- Develop a project group to deliver the action plan.
- Giuseppe will continue to update the CPN with developments including setting up the steering group after the strategy has been approved by Cabinet.

Outcome

- Three members of the coproduction network expressed an interest in being part of the work

4. Assistive technology – Vicky

Vicky provided an update about the development Assistive Technology project.

- This a collaborative and innovative approach to the use of technology to help promote independence and enhance the wellbeing of adults living in Slough.
- The project aims to ensure that adults eligible for care will have access to assistive technology free of charge
- Vicky is seeking CPN volunteers to be part of the project group.

5. Older People Strategy 2023 - 2026 - Vanessa

Vanessa provided an update on the Older People Strategy (Appendix C).

- o In summary the coproduced older people strategy identified eight priorities
 - 1 To reduce social isolation and loneliness for Older People
 - 2 Continued sense of purpose to live best life.
 - 3 To live more years in good health.
 - 4 Integration with the NHS and Public Health to prevent Long Term conditions.
 - 5 Information & Advice on the challenges that affect older people e.g. cost of living, fuel costs, food poverty, etc
 - 6 To support intergenerational families best care for their loved ones and with respect to cultural differences.
 - 7 To have a choice about end-of-life pathway.
 - 8 To have a range of housing options to suit older people in later life.

The CPN asked number of questions which included:

• What age group is the strategy aimed to support?

Response

- The strategy is created to support people who are 65yrs and over.
- What is the outreach like to care homes workshops, talks etc and links with other organisations?

Response

- One of the care home visited supports dementia residents by organising activities like pet club and gardening. There is also a quiet room for people to relax.

Actions:

- Plans to create a steering group to support the delivery of strategy and action plans are underway.
- Two volunteers from the CPN have indicated that they would like to be part of the steering group.
