The borough of Slough waiting restrictions and parking places (consolidation) order 2017 (amendment no. 34) order 2024 (order 21 of 2024) (proposed order)

Sections 1, 45, 46 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended.

1. Slough Borough Council gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under sections 1, 45, 46 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers. The effects of the Proposed Order are set out below.
2. A new “BS1” parking zone would be created for parking in selected areas of the carriageway covering all of Carlisle Road, part of Frank Sutton Way, all of Godolphin Road, all of Lake Avenue, all of Redwood Gardens, part of Whitby Road and all of Woodland Avenue.
3. The Proposed Order would introduce resident and shared use parking places and waiting restrictions operating on all days and at all times in these roads, with limited waiting in the shared use parking places operating 8am to 7pm on Mondays to Sundays inclusive.
4. Properties eligible for the issue of permits are set out in the Schedule below.

BS1	Carlisle Road	North side: Even numbers only 2a to 48 inclusive South side: Odd numbers only 1 to 63 inclusive
BS1	Frank Sutton Way	East side: Number 2 only
BS1	Godolphin Road	East side and North East sides: Even numbers only 2 to 24 inclusive West side and South West sides: Odd numbers only 1 to 27 inclusive
BS1	Lake Avenue	North side: Even numbers only 2 to 80 inclusive South side: Odd numbers only 1 to 69a inclusive Industrial Estate
BS1	Redwood Gardens	North side: Numbers 1 to 8 inclusive

Zone	Road name	Addresses eligible for permits
BS1	Whitby Road Northern Arm	North side: Even numbers 10 to 70 inclusive South Side: Odd numbers only 15 to 69 inclusive
BS1	Woodland Avenue	East and North East sides: Odd numbers only 1 to 45 inclusive South and South West sides: Even numbers only 2 to 54 inclusive

Copies of the Proposed Order, this notice and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Proposed Order may be inspected free of charge at the Council's offices during normal working hours (excluding bank and public holidays).
