THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017 (AMENDMENT NO. 47) ORDER 2025 (Order 22 of 2025) (PROPOSED ORDER)

Sections 1, 45, 46 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 7 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 as amended.

- 1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under sections 1, 45, 46 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers. The effects of the Order are set out below.
- 2. A new "CP6" parking zone would be created for parking in selected areas of the carriageway covering part of Bath Road and Galleymead Road, together with the introduction of waiting restrictions operating at all times into certain sections of Poyle New Cottages.
- 3. The Order would introduce shared use: resident parking / free short term parking, 1-hour maximum stay with no return within 1 hour parking places operating between 8am and 6pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, together with the introduction of waiting restrictions operating on all days and at all times in sections of Poyle New Cottages.
- 4. Properties eligible for the issue of permits are set out in the Schedule below.
