Precis	Construction of further industrial sites in this area will lead to increased traffic on roads which already cannot cope with the existing volumes as they are constantly in a state of disrepair and restricted for underground works. The exits from the village are clogged by either dump trucks from the multiple gravel extraction sites, heavy transport using the villages as a cut through (weight restrictions are completely ignored) or large numbers of private and light goods vehicles avoiding motorways. The destruction of part of the Poplars will reduce local green space and cut off a popular pedestrian route to the Golden Cross PH. This will necessitate driving or using a road way with only a narrow unpaved path alongside an unlit road with a 60MPH speed limit. Generators for a data centre will be extremely large and running 24/7 ensuring that any rare quiet hours will be eliminated entirely and will contribute still further to already significant atmospheric pollution. This area is also prone to significant flooding and this site will increase runoff into local watercourses increasing the likelihood and severity of flooding to local residents. All of this applies during the running of the site, but during construction I would expect all of these factors to be significantly increased during the multiple years required for construction and commissioning of the site.
