THE BOROUGH OF SLOUGH WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017 (AMENDMENT No.48) ORDER 2025 (Order 45 of 2025)

Sections 1, 45 and 46 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 21 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996.

1. SLOUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL makes this Order in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 45 and 46 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers.

2. The Order shall come into operation on on the date the notice of making is first published.

3. While the Order is in operation, the Slough Borough Council Waiting Restrictions and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2017 ('the 2017 Order') shall be amended as follows:

(a) the item relating to "approved method of payment" in Part 1: Definitions to the 2017 Order is deleted in its entirety and is replaced with the item in Schedule A to this Order.

DEFINITIONS

"approved method of payment"	means payment by: (a) debit or credit card using a mechanical device; or (b) debit or credit card facilitated by on site or remote verification by mobile phone text, phone call or application; or (c) cash, debit or credit card at a commercial premises in the borough designated as a paypoint and displaying the appropriate signage; or (d) or such other method of payment as the Council may from time to time authorise.
