

A4 Bath Road Cycle Lane Scheme Tree Felling

Under section 115 of the Environment Act 2021 Slough Borough Council has a statutory duty to consult residents on the felling of street trees where no exemptions apply. The duty to consult on felling street trees ("Duty to Consult") has been introduced to ensure local people can express their views over the proposed management of street trees in their locality. The duty will ensure the decision-making process is more transparent and considers the views of local people.

To accommodate the cycle lane and footway works, some trees along the A4 will be removed and replaced at various locations.

Drawing numbers listed below shows the trees that are to be removed:

- SBC-TH-MP-00532-P2-200-02
- SBC-TH-MP-00532-P2-200-03
