

M4 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 6 TO JUNCTION 7) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Notice is hereby given that Highways England Company Limited has made an Order on the M4 Motorway in the Unitary Authorities of Slough and Windsor & Maidenhead, under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because works are proposed to be executed on the road.

The effect of the Order is to authorise the overnight closure of:-

1. both carriageways of the M4 between Junction 6 (A355) and Junction 7 (Huntercombe Spur); and
2. all slip roads leading to and from this length of carriageway.

These measures are in the interests of road safety while contractors undertake signal works, carriageway works, highway maintenance and all associated works.

It is expected that the work will last for approximately 2 days starting on or after Monday 3rd December 2018. The overnight closures will take place between 21:00 and 06:00 (maximum period).

The Order will come into force on 1st December 2018 and have a maximum duration of eighteen months.

Traffic affected by the closures will be diverted using the A4, A355 and the Huntercombe Spur.

The temporary closures and diversion routes will be clearly indicated by traffic signs when they are in operation during the works period.
