ROAD TRAFFIC

The M4 Motorway (Junction 6 to Junction 7) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018

Made

16th November 2018

Coming into force

1st December 2018

Highways England Company Limited(a), being the traffic authority for the M4 Motorway and connecting roads in the Unitary Authorities of Slough and Windsor & Maidenhead, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that Motorway and some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

Highways England Company Limited, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14(1)(a) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(b), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The M4 Motorway (Junction 6 to Junction 7) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018 and shall come into force on 1st December 2018.

2. In this Order:-

“the M4” means the M4 Motorway in the Unitary Authorities of Slough and Windsor & Maidenhead;

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip/link road joins, or the last point where an exit slip/link road leaves the carriageway;

“the length of carriageway” means –

a) the westbound carriageway of the M4 between the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 6 (A355) and the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 7 (Huntercombe Spur); and

b) the eastbound carriageway of the M4 between the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 7 (Huntercombe Spur) and the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 6 (A355);

“a slip road” means all the roads leading to and from the length of carriageway;

“works” means signal works, carriageway works, highway maintenance and all associated works;

“the works period” means periods of 9 hours starting at 21:00 on Monday 3rd December 2018 and on any subsequent weekday until completion of the works;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway and a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; and
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

6. During the works period The M4 Motorway (Junction 1 to Junction 15) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018(a) is suspended insofar as it relates to the length of carriageway and a slip road.
